*The Cobdogla Steam Friends Society Inc would like to invite you to a gathering of miniature steam engines at the Cobdogla Irrigation & Steam Museum, the home of the unique Humphrey Pump.*

*The Museum is located in the former Cobdogla Pumping Station which supplied irrigation water to the Cobdogla, Barmera and Loveday Irrigation Settlements. Cobdogla is located approximately half way between Adelaide and Mildura on the A20 Sturt Highway, which is the interconnector between Adelaide and Sydney.*

*Featured at the museum are the Humphrey Pump, a Two Foot Gauge Railway with steam and diesel traction, two Fowler Traction engines, (a Z7 Ploughing engine, and Australia's only Crane traction engine,) vintage tractors and the local National Trust displays of the settlement of the district and the Loveday WW2 Internment Camp. An Aveling & Porter Steam Roller's restoration may also be completed in time for the rally.*

*Our recently enlarged Fowler shed with concrete floor will be available for secure overnight storage of engines.*

*We are working on a fuel supply. We do not have a ready access to char, but we could organise some of the Mallee charcoal we use in the Humphrey Pump Gas producers, (approx 20 kg bags @ \$25.00 each) and of course we have hardwood timber available. Please e-mail your requirements well in advance of the rally.*

*Sorry, we don't have enough room for overnight camping but we share a boundary with the Cobdogla Caravan Park.*

*Accommodation near the Cobdogla Irrigation & Steam Museum, all within 6 km of the museum.*
